

(n) To Reverend George Bienlein, C. S. S. R., who is now stationed at Esopus, New York, the sum of Two Hundred Dollars.

(o) To Reverend Michael G. Will, C. S. S. R., who is now stationed at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, the sum of Two Hundred Dollars.

(p) To the Catholic Orphanage, located at Nazareth, North Carolina, the sum of Two Hundred Dollars.

(q) To the Pastor (at the time of Testatrix's death) of the Roman Catholic Church at Hollstadt (Unterfranken) Bavaria, the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars.

To the bequests contained in the Last Will and Testament of Elizabeth Hagan, widow, late of Baltimore City, deceased, duly admitted to probate by the Orphans' Court of Baltimore City, and recorded in the Office of the Register of Wills of Baltimore City in Wills Liber J. H. B. No. 177, folio 519, as follows:

(d) To Saint Elizabeth's Home of Baltimore City, located at Chestnut Hill Avenue, east of Old York Road, Baltimore, Maryland, the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars.

(e) To the Associated Professors of Saint Mary's Seminary of Baltimore City, the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars, to be used toward the education of some poor young man studying for the priesthood.
