- SALARIES, INCOMES, EMOLUMENTS & PROFITS.**—If Levy Courts &c., shall not have appointed assessors of, &c. as directed by act of 1841, ch. 325, section 3, and the declaratory act of 1842, ch. 294, and said assessors shall not have qualified on or before 1st day of May, in that case Governor authorised to appoint &c., and assessors so appointed, after having qualified as prescribed, by original act, shall proceed by assessing, within their districts &c., and make return as prescribed in 7th section of original act, within two months from time of appointment, 307 1
