1839.

Resolution relating to the pay of the Members and Officers of this General Assembly. Passed Jan. 4,
1840.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore be, and he is hereby authorised to pay to the several members of the present General Assembly and the officers thereof, or to their respective orders, the several sums of money now due or that may from time to time become due to them respectively, and for which they shall obtain certificates from the chairman of the committee of claims of the present House of Delegates.

Resolution granting to Solicitors in Chancery the privileges of the Library. Passed Jan. 9,
1840.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the privileges of the State Library be extended to the Solicitors in Chancery during the terms and sessions of that court, and their attendance thereon.
