- GREEN, CAPT. N. H.**—To be furnished with knapsacks, glazed, not exceeding fifty, from Adjutant General of Maryland, 62
- GREEN, WM. S.**—Resolution in favor of, suspending all proceedings, &c. obtained by the State against &c. until the 1st of July 1840, &c. 53
