To the Clerk of the Court of Appeals:

I, JOHN R. REEVES, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, pursuant to the direction contained in Section 203 of Article 33 of the Code of Maryland (1947 Edition) DO HEREBY CERTIFY, That at the General Election held on November, 4, 1952 in the State of Maryland, an Act known as Chapter 34 of the Acts of 1951, was submitted to the voters of Baltimore County, in accordance with a petition referendum, for their adoption or rejection, under the provisions of said Chapter 34 of the Acts of 1951, said Act being:

“An Act relating to the building and acquisition of school property in Baltimore County.”

AND I DO CERTIFY, that at said election 78,896 votes were cast against the adoption of Chapter 34 of the Acts of 1951, and 20,092 votes were cast in favor of the adoption of the said Act, and a majority being cast against the adoption of said Chapter 34, the said Act has, therefore, failed of ratification.
