1844.

Resolution in favor of L. Broadwater and Wm. B. Tabler. Passed Dec. 31, 1844.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to L. Broadwater and Wm. B. Tabler, for two days attendance on the House during the present session, together with the usual itinerant charges.*

No. 2.

Resolution in favor of Mrs. Juliana Stephen, widow of the late Judge Stephen. Passed Dec. 31, 1844.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay over to Mrs. Juliana Stephen, widow of the late Judge Stephen, who departed this life on the twenty-sixth of June last, the quarter's salary which would have been due the deceased on the first of July, eighteen hundred and forty-four.*
