CHAPTER 1.

CHAP. 1.

A supplement to an act passed at December session eigh-Passed teen hundred and forty-six, chapter two hundred and Dec. 31, 1847. fifty-two, entitled, an act relating to the School Fund in Harford County.

SECTION 1.
