No. 2.

Resolution in favor of William Kline.

Passed Jan. 2, 1850.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of Maryland pay to William Cline the sum of twenty-eight dollars, in consideration of his services and expenses in attending this house at the present session of the House of Delegates, as Sergeant-at-Arms.*
