

RESOLUTIONS

ASSENTED TO BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND AT JANUARY SESSION, A. D. 1854.

No. 1.

Resolution requesting our Representatives in Congress, Passed
Jau. 27, 1854.
to urge upon the General Government the necessity and propriety of making some arrangement by treaty or otherwise, with the Peruvian Government, by which the present monopoly in the sale of Guano in this State, and other States of the Union, may be removed.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,
That our Senators and Representatives in the Congress of the United States, be earnestly and respectfully requested to urge upon the General Government the necessity and propriety of making as soon as possible, some arrangement by treaty or otherwise, with the Peruvian Government, by which the present monopoly in the sale of Guano in this State, and other States of the Union, may be removed, and the agricultural interests of our country thereby be greatly promoted.

Resolved, That the Governor of this State be requested to transmit a copy of the foregoing resolution to the Senators and Representatives in Congress from this State.
