To the Clerk of the Court of Appeals:

I, BLANCHARD RANDALL, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, pursuant to the direction contained in Section 210 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition) DO HEREBY CERTIFY, That at a Special Election held in Caroline County on Tuesday, June 14, 1955, an Act known as Chapter 321 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1955 was submitted to the voters of Caroline County, for their adoption or rejection under the provisions of Chapter 321 of the Acts of 1955, said Act being:

“An Act to authorize Caroline County to borrow up to \$1,600,-000.00, for the erection of new school facilities.”

AND I DO CERTIFY, that at said election 1,281 votes were cast in favor of the adoption of Chapter 321 of the Acts of 1955, and 3,244 votes were cast against the adoption of the said Act, and a majority of the votes being cast against the adoption of Chapter 321 of the Acts of 1955, the said Act has therefore failed of ratification.
