MARYLAND, SCT.

At a session of the General Assembly of Maryland, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, on the first Wednesday of January, being the second day of said month, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, and ended the tenth day of March of said year;

THE FOLLOWING LAWS WERE ENACTED, TO WIT :

CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT to increase the pay for labor on the public roads in Talbot County. Passed
February
27, 1856.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That for the purpose of securing labor on the public roads in Talbot county, the county commissioners for said county, be and they are hereby authorised to allow such laborers the sum of one dollar per day. County

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
