LAWS of MARYLAND. 1792. H A P. An ACT to revive and aid the proceedings of Worcester county Passed April 6. court. HEREAS the justices of Worcester county court did not meet pur-Preamble. fuant to their adjournment of November term, seventeen hundred and ninety, and divers actions, fuits and proceedings, civil and criminal, were discontinued; for aiding, therefore, the said actions, suits and proceedings, and for faving, as far as may be, parties interested from the damage that might otherwise be occasioned by such discontinuance, II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all actions, Actions, &c. to be valid. fuits and proceedings, depending in the faid court, shall be and are hereby as good and valid as if the same had been continued by the order or judgment of the faid court, any thing to the contrary notwithstanding. Judgments III. And be it enacted, That all judgments rendered at or fince faid November confirmed. term, seventeen hundred and ninety, shall be and are hereby confirmed in as full force and power as if the same suits had been regularly continued. Passed An additional supplement to the act, entitled, An act directing April 6. the time, places and manner, of holding elections for representatives of this state in the congress of the United States, and for appointing electors on the part of this state for choosing a prefident and vice-prefident of the United States, and for the regulation of the faid elections, and also to repeal the act of allembly therein mentioned. Elections to E it enaded, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the election of be made in electors for the purpose of choosing a president and vice-president of the November, United States, shall be made by the citizens of this state, qualified to vote for members of the house of delegates, on the second Wednesday in November next, and on the second Wednesday in November in every fourth year for ever thereafter. Parts of an act II. and be it enacted, That all that part of the act to which this is an addirepealed, &c. tional supplement, which directs the holding the aforesaid election at a different time from that herein before appointed, and all parts of the same which are inconfistent with the act of congress passed at a session, begun and held at the city of Philadelphia on Monday the twenty-fourth day of October, one thousand feven hundred and ninety-one, entitled, An act relative to the election of a prefident and vice-prefident of the United States, and declaring the officer who shall act as president in case of vacancies in the offices both of president and vice-prefident, shall be and the same are hereby repealed, and that, in all other respects, the election of the said electors shall be made agreeably to the provisions of the feveral acts of affembly now in force for the regulation of the same.
