LAWS OF MARYLAND

Special Session

May 25, 1962

MARYLAND, Sct.:

At a Special Session of the General Assembly of Maryland, begun and held in the City of Annapolis, on the twenty-fifth day of May, 1962, the Honorable J. Millard Tawes, being Governor of the State, the following laws were enacted, to wit:

CHAPTER 1

(House Bill 1)

AN ACT to add a new Section 42 to Article 40 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "General Assembly" to follow immediately after Section 41 thereof, and to be under the new sub-title "Apportionment", revising the provisions concerning the membership of the House of Delegates and the representation of the several political sub-divisions therein, making provision for the nomination and election of certain candidates for office in the House of Delegates, MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS FROM THE GENERAL FUND SURPLUS OF THE STATE TREASURY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1963, TO BE USED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PAY A PORTION OF THE COST OF SPECIAL PRIMARY ELECTIONS FOR THIS PURPOSE, and relating generally to the membership and election of the members of the House of Delegates of Maryland AND TO AN EMERGENCY APPRO-PRIATION FROM THE STATE TREASURY FOR THE PAY MENT OF A PORTION OF THE COST OF SPECIAL ELEC-TIONS UNDER THIS ACT.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That new Section 42 be and it is hereby added to Article 40 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "General As-
