**NOTE**

There were eight bills vetoed by the Governor of Maryland following the 1962 Regular Session of the General Assembly. Of these, three originated in the Senate and five were introduced in the House of Delegates.

Section 17 of Article 2 of the Constitution of Maryland, as last amended in 1960, provides that vetoed bills are not to be returned to the Legislature for reconsideration when a new General Assembly has been elected and sworn since the passage of the bill. Accordingly, because of the elections in 1962, these vetoes are final unless the General Assembly meets in Special Session prior to the swearing-in of the General Assembly of 1963.
