

Resolution authorizing the Librarian to subscribe for three hundred copies of Merrick, Stockett and Miller's Digest of the Decisions of the Court of Appeals and of the Court of Chancery;

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the State Librarian be and he is hereby authorized and directed to subscribe in the name of the State, for three hundred copies of Merrick, Stockett and Miller's Digest of the Decisions of the Court of Appeals and Courts of Chancery of this State: *provided* the price thereof shall not exceed ten dollars per copy: and *provided further,* any three judges of the Court of Appeals shall certify under their hands and seals, that in their opinion the said Digest is a faithful digest of said decisions and deserves the patronage of the State.

And the Librarian is further directed to distribute the same number of copies of said digest and in the same way as the copies of the Maryland Reports are now authorized by law to be distributed, and the residue to sell or exchange for such other books as may be required in the State Library, *Provided* nevertheless, that he shall retain thirty-five copies in the Library for the use thereof.

Mr. Daniel moved to strike out "three hundred" and insert "two hundred;"

Which was determined in the affirmative.

The Resolution as amended was then passed and sent to the Senate.
