CHAPTER 3.

Passed June 18, 1812.

*A supplement to the act entitled, An act to incorporate a bank to be called "The Farmers' Bank of Somerset and Worcester.*

Directors authorised to appoint a president and other officers—grant compensations, &c.

SEC. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the board of directors of the bank appointed agreeably to the seventh section of the said law, at their first meeting, and at their first meeting after every annual election, shall have power to appoint a president for the said bank, and all other officers requisite for transacting the business of the company, and to allow such compensation for their services respectively, as shall be reasonable. No director shall be entitled to any emolument unless the same shall have been allowed by the stock-holders at a general meeting. The stock-holders shall make such compensation to the president for his extraordinary attendance at the bank, as shall appear to them reasonable.

CHAPTER 4.

Passed June 18, 1812.

*An act authorising an appropriation for the penitentiary of this state.*

8000 dollars appropriated.

SEC. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the inspectors of the penitentiary of this state, or any seven of them, be, and they are hereby authorised, from time to time, to draw orders on the treasurer of the Western Shore for any sums of money not exceeding in the whole eight thousand dollars, which orders the said treasurer is hereby required to pay out of any unappropriated money in the treasury, to be applied by the said inspectors or a majority of them towards the purchase of tools, raw materials and provisions, or other necessary articles for the use and benefit of the said penitentiary, in such manner as they shall direct and determine; and shall be accounted for in such manner as is prescribed by the act passed at November session eighteen hundred and eleven, entitled, An act authorising appropriations for the penitentiary of this state.
