A Bill entitled: An Act to repeal Section 40(c) of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1963 Supplement), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact," subtitle "State's Attorney," and to enact a new Section 40(c) in lieu thereof to stand in the place of the section so repealed, providing for a personal expense allowance and the payment of additional compensation for the State's Attorney of Anne Arundel County, for an increase in the minimum salaries of the deputy State's Attorney and assistant State's Attorneys of Anne Arundel County, for an increase in the number of assistant State's Attorneys for Anne Arundel County, and for the appointment of a clerk for the office of the State's Attorney of Anne Arundel County.

A Bill entitled: An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 98A (d) of Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1963 Supplement), title "Justices of the Peace," subtitle "Trial Magistrates System," providing for the appointment of one additional substitute judge of the People's Court for Prince George's County and fixing the term thereof.
