A Bill entitled: An Act to add new Section 158A to Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Motor Vehicles," subtitle "Unsatisfied Claim and Judgment Fund," to follow immediately after Section 158 thereof, to provide that persons holding valid automobile liability insurance policies issued by companies authorized to do business under the Insurance Code meet motor vehicle financial responsibility requirements regardless of the insolvency or inability of the insurer to pay judgments against the insured, and to provide that such policyholders need not pay uninsured motorist fees except upon certain conditions.
