said Henry Woodward his Heirs and Assigns All those several following Tracts or parcels of Land
lying and being in Ann Arundel County aforesaid that is to say All that Tract or parcel of Land
called Homewood's Lot containing Thirteen hundred and Ninety two Acres of Land all that part
of a Tract of Land called Mill Town alias Young Richard containing six Acres granted
William Cumming Esquire for forty six Acres All that Tract or parcel of Land called Henrietta
Maria's Cove for Mary Chew containing Eight and a half Acres of Land granted Charles Homewood
All that part of Homewood's Chance and Blays Neck containing Ten Acres, Homewood's Chance
granted John Homewood Esquire for three hundred Acres and Blays Neck granted Edward Blay
