

CHAPTER 484

(House Bill 969)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Environmental Policy Act--Historic Resources

FOR the purpose of including historic resources among those resources which should be protected by State agencies, and including historical environmental effects in "environmental effects report" , and defining historic resources .

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 448(b) and 449(c) of Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 41 - Governor-Executive and Administrative

The General Assembly of Maryland finds and declares that:

(b) All State agencies must conduct their affairs with an awareness that they are stewards of the air, land, water, [and] living AND HISTORIC resources, and that they have an obligation to protect the environment for the use and enjoyment of this and all future generations;

(c) The term "environmental effects report" means a report on each proposed State action significantly
