

RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Governor hereby declare the first Saturday in April of each year as Ride a Bicycle Day in Maryland, to encourage and promote the sport of bicycling among the citizens of Maryland, and be it further

RESOLVED, That copies of this Resolution be sent to the State Department of Forest and Parks, the County Executives and County Commissioners in the State, the Mayor of Baltimore City and other municipalities suggesting that Ride a Bicycle Day be promoted through various special activities such as, family bike hikes, bicycle tours through state and county parks, bicycle rides along specially designated routes in cities and towns, bicycle rodeos for young people, bicycle safety inspections, and other bicycle oriented activities appropriate for particular areas of the State.
