year of our Lord Seventeen hundred thirty & five that he should  
take Lidia Check late of Shert County if she shall be found in his Bail-  
- with and her safe keep so that you her body before the Justice of our  
next County Court to be hold at our Court house in the Town of Chester  
in said County on the third tuesday of March next to answer unto  
a certain presentment for selling of Liquor contrary to an Act of  
Assembly made & provided in such cases & - AND that the Sher  
of said County have at the time & place aforesaid the said precept -

And now here at this day to wit the sixteenth day of March  
in the Year aforesaid Com<sup>rs</sup> William Harris Gent Sher of said County and  
made return thereof to the Court here thereof Endowed as folo Viz<sup>z</sup>  
Shert County pt. Episcopus W. Harris Sher

Be it remembred that Smith Francis Gent Attorney of the right -  
Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is who for the same Lord Prop<sup>rs</sup>  
in this part presenteth doth come her into the County Court of the same  
Lord Proprietary held for Shert County aforesaid to wit at Chester Town in the  
same County the third tuesday in November Anno Domini Seventeen  
hundred thirty & five before James Harris Esq<sup>r</sup> & his Associate the said  
Lord Proprietary his Justice of the same County Court and for the same  
Lord Prop<sup>rs</sup> doth give the same Justice hereto understand and be-  
informed Lidia Check late of Shrowbury parish in the County aforesaid  
the first day of March Anno Domini Seventeen hundred thirty and  
five at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction  
of this Court then an Inhabitant of this Province of Maryland -  
being did sell by retail to Thomas Morwell of the same County planter  
One gill of rum at and for a price different from and greatly exceeding
