Know all men by these presents that David Solihaw Rawdon of London Widow Ex^{te} of my last will and Testament of Sir John Rawdon late of London Knight my late husband doe for divers good causes and considerations me hereunto moving have made consulted and appointed by these presents do make ordaine constitute and appoint his Ex^{ty} Sir Francis Nicholson Governour of Maryland my true and Lawfull atty for me and in my hand and to my self to ask demand and receive of and from Richard Tostler and of and from Elizabeth Diggs Widdow of Colich of son William Diggs late of Maryland atty Doe. and of and from all and every other person and persons whatsoever that doe or shall inhabit or reside in Maryland of this all and every such sums and sums of money Tobacco goods and Merchandise whatsoever as or shall be any wayes or upon any account due or belonging to me to me either in my own Right or as Ex^{te} of my said husband, and of said Tostler to me, And also for me and in my hand to sell and adjust amount to my said Richard Tostler and Elizabeth Diggs and to all and every of said persons and to make composition wth them or any of them for any debts by them respectively owing to me and to receipt of sums and sums of money or other satisfaction for and discharge of my said debts or any of them as my said atty shall think fitting and upon his receipt of what shall upon adjusting such account or making such such composition or otherwise be due to me or of any part thereof receipt augmentation or release or any other discharge for me and in my hand to make execute and give in part or in full as by these presents shall require, And also to carry on any suits already begun or to comence or prosecute any other suits or suits or to sue for any proceeds for me and in my hand, against my said Richard Tostler and Elizabeth Diggs and any other person and persons or any of them their or any of their Ex^{ors} or Adm^{ors} and them or any of them their every or any of their goods chattels Lands or Tenements in Execution to take and out of Execution to deliver at my will and pleasure of my said atty giving and hereby granting unto my said atty my full power and authority in and touching the premises and to subscribe and appoint and to make atty and atty under him and generally to do or cause to be done all and every such further and other Lawfull acts matters and things in and touching the premises or any of them as shall be needfull and convenient to be done as fully and effectually as I my self could do if I were personally present, and whatsoever my said atty shall Lawfully do or cause to be done in & touching the premises by virtue of these presents I shall and will, do here by doo ratify and confirm and allowe all Intents and purposes And I do hereby revoke make void countermande and annull all and every such Letters Letters of atty powers commissions and orders as have been by me at any time here before made or given to my said Richard Tostler and all by power and authority hereby or by any of them to him given and doo declare the same to be from henceforth absolutely void and of none effect, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the 10th and thirteenth day of August Anno domini 1698, and in the Tenth year of my said Sovereign King William the Third by the grace of God King of England &c.

Maryland To all Christian People to whom this present writing shall come, Knowe you, That I Barnabie Dryer of the County of Annapolis in the Province of Maryland Planter for and consideration of my natural love and affection which I now have and bear to my most dear and well beloved wife Susannah Dryer and for her better support after my decease if it shall please God my said Susannah should happen to survive me as likewise in consideration that my said wife doth accept this deed of Gift in full satisfaction of her Dowry doo hereby give and grant in full and confirmed and doo by this present writing give grant in full and confirmed unto my said Dear and loving wife Susannah Dryer her heirs and assigns for ever, all those two pieces and parcels of Land which I now have and possess being wife Susannah Dryer her heirs and assigns for ever, all those two pieces and parcels of Land which I now have and possess called and known by the names of Spencers Field and The Spencers Range and contained by Survey two hundred acres of Land which I purchased of Nicholas Theopart and all that piece or parcel of Land adjoining called or known by the name of Chelton and contained by Ballont of Survey forty acres which I purchased of one Richard Brown And also that piece and parcel of Land lying on the West Side of a Branch of Potomack River called and known by the name of Dryers Inheritance taken up and granted to me by Ballont 30th day of March 1695, and layd by Survey for two hundred and fifty, and four acres of Land more or less to my said Dear and loving wife her heirs and assigns for ever to have only use and behoof of my said Dear and loving wife her heirs and assigns for ever all which four parcels
