ensuing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof
he the said William Stevenson doth hereby acknowledge
and there of and therefrom doth acquit and discharge the
said Thomas Johnson Jun^r. his Heirs, Executors, Administrators
and Assigns and every of them by these presents Hath
given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released, enfeoffed,
and confirmed and by these presents Doth give, grant
bargain, sell, alien, release, enfeoff and confirm unto him
the said Thomas Johnson Jun^r. his Heirs and Assigns, All
those four Lots of Ground lying and being in the City of
Annapolis aforesaid contiguous and adjoining to each other
which were devised by Thomas Bordley Esq^r. deceased to his Sons
John and Thomas and which are distinguished in the plat of
the Survey of the said City made by James Stoddart by
the Numbers of Ninety two, Ninety Three, One hundred and
four and One hundred and Five. Together with all Houses
Buildings, Gardens, Ways, Waters, Easements, profits
Commodities Advantages and Appurtenances whatsoever
