- 1—Property tax relief and credit for certain homeowners—Provides real property tax credit program by increasing cigarette and increasing certain inheritance tax rate; general..... 11, 22, 36
- 2—Police protection fund—Increases State aid to certain subdivisions by changing per capita amounts, increasing certain tax rates and providing for collection..... 13, 30, 36
- 3—Expenses of the Special Session—Emergency appropriation..... 14, 20, 36
- 4—Rent Control—Sets new automatic expiration date on certain provisions and provides for certain exceptions..... 15
- 5—Commission on Afro-American and Indian History and Culture—Changes to single purpose commission by deleting references to "Indian"..... 15
- 6—Alcoholic beverage tax—Enables imposition by political subdivisions..... 16
- 7—Cigarette tax—Permits imposition by local subdivisions and provides for collection and distribution..... 16
- 8—Cigarette tax—Provides for distribution of additional funds to subdivisions where collected..... 17
- 9—State cigarette tax—Includes as part of basic cost for purposes of the Unfair Cigarette Sales Tax..... 17
- 10—Alcoholic beverages—Bases tax rate on cost per gallon to dealer, and provides for method of collection..... 18
