

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 14(d)(4) of Article 75 1/2 - Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1975 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 75 1/2 - Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors

14.

(d) (4) If after a third failure an applicant desires a conference with a member of the Board, he must file a petition within 45 days after the date of mailing to him, at his last known address on file with the Board, notice of his third [failure, the] FAILURE. THE Board shall not be required to grant a conference to any applicant who does not file his petition within the time limited in this subsection.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
