(e) (1) On and after January 1, 1977, certified public accountants who have certificates, and who have registered under the provisions of this [title] ARTICLE, shall comply with continuing education requirements adopted by the Board as a prerequisite to the issuance or renewal of registrations to engage in the practice of public accounting.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
