RESCIUTION NO. CA-1-77  
 OF THE  
 MAYOR AND ALDERMAN OF THE  
 CITY OF ANNAPOLIS  
 TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT  
 SECTION 1 (b) - OF THE CITY CHARTER

Resolution of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11-E of the Constitution of the State of Maryland and Article 23-A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Replacement Volume), titled "Corporations-Municipal", to repeal and re-enact Section 1 (b) of the Charter of the City of Annapolis for the purpose of increasing the salary of the Mayor from \$18,000.00 per year to \$25,000.00 per year beginning on June 13, 1977 and increasing the salary of each Alderman from \$4,000.00 per year to \$5,000.00 per year beginning on June 13, 1977, re-enacting all other provisions of Section 1 (b) of the Charter, and all matters relating generally.

 SECTION 40 - OF THE CITY CHARTER

Resolution of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11 E of the Constitution of the State of Maryland and Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Replacement Volume), as amended, titled "Corporations-Municipal", to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 40 of the Charter of the City of Annapolis for the purpose of providing that a person may appeal the decision of the Port Wardens to the Mayor and Aldermen; re-enacting all other provisions of Section 40 of the Charter not inconsistent with this amendment and all matters relating generally thereto.
