Bill No. 126-78

AN ORDINANCE to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 12-802 of the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplements), Title 12, "Licenses, Permits and Franchises", Subtitle 8, "Electrical", and to add new Section 12-802A to the same Code, Title and Subtitle, to adopt the National Electrical Code (1978 Edition) as the basic electrical code for the County and to provide for amendments to the text of the National Electrical Code (1978 Edition) and matters generally related thereto.

Bill No. 2-79

AN ORDINANCE to repeal Sections 12-2100 through 12-2108, inclusive, of the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplements), Title 12, "Licenses, Permits and Franchises", Subtitle 21, "Swimming Pools", and to enact new Sections 12-2100 through 12-2109, inclusive, to said Code, Title and Subtitle, to stand in the place of the sections repealed, to require the licensing of public pools, operators and lifeguards; to provide fees, standards and regulations therefor, and to provide penalties for the violation thereof; and matters generally related thereto.

AN ORDINANCE to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 1-215 V. B. of the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplements), Title 1, "Administration", Subtitle 2, "Personnel", Article II, "Classified Service", and to enact new Section 1-217(26A) to said Code, Title, Subtitle and Article to create the new position of Assistant Director, Department of Public Works, and to provide standards and salary scale for said position and matters generally related thereto.

AN ORDINANCE to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 11A-1800 of the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplements), Title 11A, "Housing, Maintenance and Occupancy Code", Subtitle 18, "Emergencies", to provide
