RESOLUTION NO. 59

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TOWN COMMISSIONERS ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ARTICLE 11-E OF THE CONSTITUTION OF MARYLAND, AND SECTION 19 OF ARTICLE 23A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND, 1957 (1973 REPLACEMENT VOLUME) ENTITLED "CORPORATIONS MUNICIPAL," TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF BEL AIR AND SECTION 1104 THEREOF TO PROVIDE INCREASED PENALTIES FOR MISDEMEANORS AND TO PROVIDE FOR FINES NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING NINETY (90) DAYS AND TO PROVIDE FOR MUNICIPAL INFRACTIONS.
