AN ACT concerning

Fire Prevention Commission - Composition

FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the State Fire Prevention Commission; providing that certain members shall reside in certain regions; and generally relating to the composition of the State Fire Prevention Commission.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 38A - Fires and Investigations

(a) There is hereby created a State Fire Prevention Commission, which shall consist of [seven] 9 persons, qualified by experience and training to deal with the matters which are the responsibilities of the Commission,
