

Consonant to Reason and not contrary but as used as above said by  
 may be agreed to the Laws Statutes and Customs of England and of  
 the said Province of Maryland which said By Laws Ordinances  
 being Ratified and Confirmed by our selfe or our heires or our Exors  
 of the said Province for the time being shall be observed kept and  
 performed by all manner of persons trading and living within the  
 City under such Reasonable Paines Penalties and Forfeitures as shall be  
 imposed by the said Major Recorder Aldermen and Common Council  
 or the Major part of them then assembled from time to time for the  
 said Paines Penalties and Forfeitures to be levied by Distress and  
 Sale of the Goods of such persons so offending and to be employed  
 for the Publique Benefit of the said City at the said District where  
 said By Laws and Orders shall be also Repoleable or liable to be re-  
 mitigated or Altered at the will of our selfe our heires or our  
 Exors and by the said Major Recorder Aldermen and Common Council  
 of the said City for the time being and the said Justices of the Peace  
 to have and to hold our Market weekly within the said City on  
 every Saturday in the said Week in some convenient Place to be  
 chosen by them appointed within the precincts of the said City and also  
 our said yearly to be kept on the third and twentieth day of  
 February in every Year for the Sale and vending of all manner  
 of Goods Cattle Merchandises and all other Commodities whatsoever  
 to sell but a Reasonable toll upon such Goods wares Merchandises  
 and other Commodities as shall be to be levied in respect whereof as shall  
 be thought fit by our selfe our heires or our Exors and of our  
 said Province for the time being and shall and may also have and  
 hold a Court of Record during the said year for the determination  
 of all Controversies and Quarrels which may happen there in according
