intermarried with Wm. T. Taylor, and a lunatic son name unknown.

The first four parties with their husbands, executed a deed to Robert F. Kennedy, for their respective interest, being one-fifth each, and making four-fifth conveyed of said $31\frac{1}{4}$ acres, Jan'y 28, 1850, (Recorded Liber J. N., No. 5, folios 247, 248 and 249.) Robert F. Kennedy's estate was decreed to be sold by decree in Chancery No. 1580, and Jacob Fiery, Trustee, appointed to make sale, which proceeding appears to be correct, and the bill states in said proceeding that his interest in said $31\frac{1}{4}$ acres of which this 10 acres for a Cemetery is a part, consists of four-fifths.

The Hickman heirs, all reside out of the State of Maryland, some in Virginia, some in the West. I cannot find out whether this Lunatic son, who owned one-fifth of said 314 acres, is deceased or living, or whether there has been any change with the other heirs by death, or marriage since the execution of the deed to R. F. Kenney.
