(1) A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE PRESIDENT.

(2) A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE SPEAKER.

## 2-704. OFFICERS.

## (A) IN GENERAL.

THE PRESIDENT AND THE SPEAKER:

(1) JOINTLY SHALL APPOINT A CHAIRMAN AND A VICE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE; OR

(2) EACH SHALL APPOINT A COCHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE.

## (B) TENURE.

APPOINTEES SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY.
