## Task-Force-on-Hunger-in-Maryland Governor's Task Force on Food and Nutrition

FOR the purpose of requesting the Governor to establish-a-Task Force-on-Hunger-in-Maryland-to-examine--and--report--on--the extent-of-the-problem;-providing-for-membership;-appointment and--staffing--of-the; Task-Force extend the existence of the Task Force on Food and Nutrition for a certain period of time; providing that the Task Force report to the Governor and the General Assembly by a certain date; and generally relating to establishing a Task Force on Hunger in Maryland.

WHEREAS, An increasing number of individuals in the State of Maryland are receiving less than the amounts of food required for proper nutrition, sustaining general good health, and survival; and

WHEREAS, The problems of hunger in the State are extensive; and

WHEREAS, Current State programs do not adequately address the problems of hunger in Maryland; and

WHEREAS, There is a pressing need to implement a comprehensive strategy in the State of Maryland for providing food assistance to needy individuals; and

WHEREAS, There is a need to identify the areas where the largest number of individuals in need of food assistance for survival are located in the State in order for the State to develop an efficient means of resolving the problem; and
