

SUBDIVISION WITHIN THE REGION, NOT LESS THAN 60 DAYS PRIOR TO A PUBLIC HEARING.

(B) NOTICE OF THE HEARING SHALL BE GIVEN BY PUBLICATION IN NEWSPAPERS OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN EACH OF THE 3 COUNTIES COMPRISING THE COUNCIL, AT LEAST ONCE PER WEEK FOR A PERIOD OF 3 WEEKS BEFORE THE HEARING.

(C) (1) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE PLANNING MAY MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE COUNCIL, ON OR BEFORE THE DATE OF THE HEARING, FOR ITS MODIFICATION WHERE NECESSARY TO ACHIEVE CONFORMITY WITH STATE PLANS AND POLICIES.

(2) EACH LOCAL PLANNING COMMISSION AND GOVERNING BODY OF EACH GOVERNMENTAL SUBDIVISION WITHIN THE REGION MAY MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE COUNCIL WITH RESPECT TO THE EFFECT OF THE PLAN WITHIN ITS GOVERNMENTAL SUBDIVISION ON OR BEFORE THE DATE OF THE HEARING.

(D) UPON ADOPTION OF THE PLAN BY THE COUNCIL AFTER PUBLIC HEARING, THE COUNCIL MAY NOT ESTABLISH ANY POLICIES OR TAKE ANY ACTION WHICH DOES NOT CONFORM TO THE PLAN.

(E) (1) THE PLAN MAY BE AMENDED IN THE SAME MANNER AS PROVIDED FOR THE ORIGINAL ADOPTION.

(2) THE COUNCIL WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO AMEND THE PLAN IN THE ORIGINAL MANNER FOR REVISIONS WHICH ARE NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE FOR THE STATISTICAL AND INFORMATIONAL UPDATE OF THE PLAN.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 862

(House Bill 1682)

AN ACT concerning

Marriage Ceremony - Fee - Prince George's County

FOR the purpose of altering the organization to which the clerk of the circuit court for Prince George's County is required to pay a certain amount of each fee for performing marriage ceremonies; providing for the transfer of certain funds collected prior to the effective date of this Act.
