(C) "ALCOHOL MISUSE" MEANS:

(1) UNLAWFUL USE OF ALCOHOL;

(2) ALCOHOL ABUSE; OR

(3) ALCOHOL DEPENDENCE.

(D) "ALCOHOL ABUSE" MEANS A DISEASE THAT IS CHARACTERIZED
BY A PATTERN OF PATHOLOGICAL USE OF ALCOHOL WITH REPEATED
ATTEMPTS TO CONTROL ITS USE, AND WITH SIGNIFICANT NEGATIVE
CONSEQUENCES IN AT LEAST ONE OF THE FOLLOWING AREAS OF LIFE:
MEDICAL, LEGAL, FINANCIAL, OR PSYCHO-SOCIAL.

(E) "ALCOHOL DEPENDENCE" MEANS A DISEASE CHARACTERIZED BY:

(1) ALCOHOL ABUSE; AND

(2) PHYSICAL SYMPTOMS OF WITHDRAWAL OR TOLERANCE.

(F) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE ADMINISTRATION.

(G) "DRUG" MEANS:

(1) A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE THAT IS
REGULATED UNDER THE MARYLAND CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES ACT;
