AN ACT concerning

Tort Claims Act - Housing Authorities

FOR the purpose of adding certain housing authorities to the meaning of local government for purposes of civil liability and immunity under the Maryland Local Government Tort Claims Act.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
