CHAPTER 15

(Senate Bill 84)

AN ACT concerning

Dorchester County - Public Dock Regulation

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Dorchester County to adopt regulations concerning the operation and maintenance of certain public harbor facilities; authorizing the County Commissioners to impose certain penalties for certain violations; and generally relating to regulation of public harbor facilities in Dorchester County.

BY adding to

Article 25 - County Commissioners Section 11C-1 Annotated Code of Maryland (1987 Replacement Volume and 1988 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 25 - County Commissioners

11C-1.

- (A) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DORCHESTER COUNTY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF PUBLIC DOCKS, PIERS, WHARVES, AND HARBOR FACILITIES OWNED OR LEASED BY THE COUNTY.
- (B) THE REGULATIONS AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY INCLUDE PROVISIONS FOR PERMITS, BERTHS, MOORING, SWIMMING, TRASH DISPOSAL AND REMOVAL, AND SUNKEN VESSELS.
- (C) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY ADOPT PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THESE REGULATIONS, INCLUDING FINES OF UP TO \$500, IMPRISONMENT OF UP TO 6 MONTHS, OR BOTH.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
