

Public Works, a recipient of the proceeds of a loan under this Act shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Board that none of the proceeds of the loan or any matching funds have been or are being used for a purpose prohibited by this Act.

SECTION 12. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1993.

CHAPTER 74

(Senate Bill 64)

AN ACT concerning

Driver's License - Suspension - Restricted License

FOR the purpose of providing that a suspension, revocation, or restriction of a Maryland driver's license by the Motor Vehicle Administration is effective at the time of the decision unless otherwise ordered; providing that credit for a period of restriction does not commence until the Motor Vehicle Administration is in possession of the licensee's driver's license or in possession of a certain certification concerning that license; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the suspension and revocation of drivers' licenses.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

16-210.

(a) On canceling, suspending, or revoking a driver's license, the Administration shall require that the license be surrendered to and retained by the Administration.

(b) At the end of a suspension period, the Administration shall return the driver's license to the licensee.

(c) WHEN THE ADMINISTRATION SUSPENDS OR REVOKES A MARYLAND DRIVER'S LICENSE OR ISSUES A RESTRICTED LICENSE, THE SUSPENSION, REVOCATION, OR RESTRICTION IS EFFECTIVE AT THE TIME THE DECISION IS RENDERED, UNLESS OTHERWISE ORDERED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
