SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act is contingent on the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 2 of Chapter 355 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1992. If that termination provision takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be void. This Act may not be interpreted to have any effect on that termination provision.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993.
