equip facilities to house rehabilitation patient care and associated support services, provided that:

- (1) The State shall expedite the process for finding an alternative use, such as State offices, for the existing Montebello Center site;
- (2) Should no alternative use be found within 6 months of UMMS vacating the facility, UMMS shall expend whatever funds are necessary for demolition and landscaping of the Montebello facility. No part of these funds may be from State funds. The demolition and landscaping shall be complete within one year after UMMS begins to admit patients at its new rehabilitation hospital;
- (3) The State shall consult with the City of Baltimore and appropriate affected community organizations in determining an acceptable use for the Montebello site;
- (4) If necessary for State offices OR UNIVERSITIES to occupy the facility UPON VACANCY BY UMMS, the University of Maryland Medical System shall pay for Fasbestos abatement? REMOVAL OF ASBESTOS at Montebello .........
