Negro Daniel

Be it remembered & it is hereby certified that the following Deed of Manumission was recorded on the 2^d day of July A. D. 1850, To Wit:

To all whom it may concern, be it known that I, Minos Adams, of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland, for divers good cause & considerations, me therunto moving, as also in further consideration of the sum of Twenty dollars, current money, to me in hand paid, have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted & set free, and by these presents do hereby release from slavery, liberate, manumit & set free, my Negro Man named Daniel, being of the age of forty years, and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood & maintenance, and him the said Negro Man named Daniel I do declare to be henceforth free, manumitted & discharged from all manner of service or servitude to me, my Executors or Administrators forever.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twentieth^{month} day of June 1850 in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred & fifty.

State of Maryland, Dorchester County, To Wit: On this twentieth^{month} day of June in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred & fifty, personally appeared Minos Adams, the party to the above instrument of Writing, before me the subscriber, a Justice of the Peace, in & for the County & State aforesaid, and acknowledged the same to be his act & deed for the purpose above mentioned, and the Negro Man above named to be henceforth manumitted and discharged from all service to him or to any claiming under him, and to be free and manumitted according to the acts of Assembly in such cases made and provided.
