To Have and to Hold, the above property as bargained and sold unto the said Algermon Thomas his heirs, executors or administrators and assigns forever, against me the said Peter Brinsfield my heirs executors or administrators and against all persons whatsover, with warrant and defend. - In Witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this twentieth day of July Anno Domini 1850.
