To have and to hold the said negroes Apsy, Elizabeth, Ann, James, William, Mary Jane, Sarah Catharine and Milley, as above bargained and sold, unto the said Margaret Landen, her heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, against me the said Thomas Hubbard, my heirs, Executors and Administrators, and against all and every other person or persons, shall and will answer and defend. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty ninth day of May 1847.
