A person who violates any provision of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both.

18-601.

This title may be cited as the "Maryland Security Systems Technicians Act".

18-701.

~~Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act, this~~ ~~THIS~~ title and all regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and be of no further force and effect after September [31, 2001] ~~30, 2000~~ 30, 2004.

**CHAPTER 521**

**(House Bill 1138)**

AN ACT concerning

**Childhood Lead Screening Program**

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to establish and administer a Lead Poisoning Screening Program, for certain purposes, and using certain criteria, screening methods, and payment mechanisms; requiring the Department of the Environment to assist local governments to provide case management for certain individuals; requiring screening of certain individuals residing in certain areas; requiring certain documentation to be provided to certain child care providers within a certain period; requiring the Department of the Environment, in conjunction with certain other units, to develop and report on a certain plan by a certain date; requiring a certain case management program to be in place by a certain date; deleting obsolete language; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to lead screening of children.
