AN ACT Concerning

Zoning - Right to Farm Law

For the purpose of protecting the right to farm and to engage in agricultural or forestry operations; to provide for persons who engage in agricultural or forestry operations to be immune from private nuisance actions involving agricultural or forestry operations in certain circumstances; to establish an Agricultural Reconciliation Board to arbitrate disputes involving agricultural or forestry operations; to require a person claiming a nuisance involving agricultural or forestry operations to seek and obtain relief from the Agricultural Reconciliation Board and the Board of Zoning Appeals; to require a person claiming a nuisance to pay reasonable expenses, including attorney fees, in certain circumstances and providing for certain notices relating thereto; and generally relating to the authority of the County Commissioners to protect agricultural or forestry operations in Worcester County.
