A BILL TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR CREATION OF SANITARY SEWER CONSTRUCTION DISTRICTS, TO ALLOCATE DESIGN, ENGINEERING, CONSTRUCTION, AND OTHER COSTS PRO-RATA AMONG THE PROPERTY OWNERS PROPOSING OR COMPRISING THE DISTRICT, AND TO ALLOW RECOUPMENT OF THOSE COSTS BY THE COUNTY THROUGH BENEFIT ASSESSMENTS ON THE PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT.

Bill No. 793, 2000 Legislative Session

A BILL TO AMEND TITLE 19. ZONING, OF THE TALBOT COUNTY CODE, BY AMENDING SECTION 19.11 (c) (1) (iii) DETERMINATION OF THE HARBOR LINE, CHANGING THE MAXIMUM FOOTAGE FROM THE MEAN HIGH WATER LINE FROM FIVE HUNDRED (500) FEET TO THREE HUNDRED (300) FEET, THE INTENT OF WHICH IS TO REDUCE THE MAXIMUM POSSIBLE LENGTH OF A PIER FROM FIVE HUNDRED (500) FEET TO THREE HUNDRED (300) FEET.
