It is hereby certified that at the election Chapter 205 received 499,689 votes cast for the adoption and 799,654 votes cast against the adoption. Therefore, Chapter 205 has been rejected by the voters.

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 33, Section 11-601, Annotated Code of Maryland, and the Code of Maryland Regulations, COMAR 33.08, I, Linda H. Lamone, Administrator of the State Board of Elections, hereby certify that at the November 7, 2000, General Election Chapter 75 of the Acts of the 2000 Maryland General Assembly was submitted to the voters of Baltimore County in accordance with the provisions of Article XVI of the Maryland Constitution as follows:

Question 3

Countywide Referendum

Baltimore County - Neighborhood Renewal Authority

Expressly authorizes Baltimore County to acquire and develop or dispose of property within certain described areas (Essex Middle River Waterfront area, the Yorkway area in Dundalk, and the Liberty Road area) for declared public neighborhood renewal purposes by amending a public local law; designates specific properties eligible for acquisition by eminent domain following the adoption of an implementation plan; requires the County to pay the owner just compensation for property acquired by eminent domain and to offer financial assistance and payments to displaced property owners or tenants; authorizes the County to sell properties acquired by eminent domain only if investment in the property equals or exceeds the purchase price paid by the County; and terminates the granted eminent domain powers on July 1, 2007.

It is hereby certified that at the election Chapter 75 received 87,971 votes cast for the adoption and 199,495 votes cast against the adoption. Therefore, Chapter 75 has been rejected by the voters.
