AN ACT TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT WITH AN AMENDMENT, SECTION 3-2, ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 3 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF KENT COUNTY, 1994 EDITION, TITLE "KENT COUNTY" SUB-TITLE "ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT" TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF KENT COUNTY.

Bill No. 5-2002

AN ACT to add new Chapter 36, Human Relations Commission, to the Code of Public Local Laws of Kent County, Maryland, establishing the Kent County Human Relations Commission; providing for the membership, purposes, goals, powers, and duties of the Commission; to provide for satisfaction of the 180 days statutory deadline for filing complaints with the Maryland Commission on Human Relations upon the filing of a written request for alternative dispute resolution with the Kent County Human Relations Commission; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the establishment of the Kent County Human Relations Commission.
